

This letter of interest in an allocation of Federal power is in response to the FRN Post-2010 Resource Pool, Pick-Sloan Missouri Basin Program – Eastern Division request for letters of interest in an allocation of Federal power for delivery beginning January 1, 2011.

Grove City of Grove City is a municipal power system operating under the laws of the State of Minnesota. Grove City is located in central Minnesota. We do not receive, directly or indirectly, any benefit from a current Federal power allocation.

Our mission is to provide low cost, reliable power to our community. We serve 376 retail customers. Federal power would become an important part of the power supply resources that we use to provide service to these customers.

Heartland Consumers Power District will be our full-requirements power supplier at the time the allocation is available for delivery and has agreed to allow us to incorporate a Federal power allocation as a primary resource. Heartland has acquired the necessary firm transmission service between the Integrated System and our electric system for delivery of the Federal power. Heartland is also willing to schedule this resource through the MISO system on our behalf.

We look forward to working with you to make this valuable resource available to our community.
