Mr. Moe,

The Moapa Valley Water District service territory covers the northern tip of the Overton arm of Lake Mead, encompassing the towns of Overton, Logandale, Glendale, Moapa, Warm Springs and the Moapa Band of Paiutes Indian Reservation.

The Moapa Valley Water District currently does not receive a power allocation from the Boulder Canyon Project.

Residents of the displaced town of St. Thomas (caused by the creation of the Boulder Dam Project) relocated to the towns currently serviced by the District. Where many of their descendants; still reside and work to this day.

The District does not receive an allocation of the Colorado River Water

The District supplies water service to the Moapa Band of Paiutes Indian Reservation.

The Districts rate structure is largely influenced by power costs, securing a power allocation will help allow the District to maintain a low rates structure for the displaced descendants of St. Thomas and the Moapa Band of Paiutes Indian Reservation.

The District feels it should receive special consideration for any Post 2017 Power Resource allocations the Western Area Power Administration will allocate.
