

some customers moving to the MSTR. However, when questioned, Western's representative stated that this was revenue that will be received regardless. This "other revenue" should therefore not be considered in this decision. It may make reduced rate shock if the new sales do not materialize, but it would imply rate reduction (or smaller increases) without the MSTR.

In summary, Tonopah appreciates Western's effort to find a way to increase sales and reduce rates, but we are opposed to the MSTR as currently proposed.
