We have participated in the public information forums concerning marketing of Parker-Davis Project Pool Power and Energy. Our entity was a successful applicant. We are writing to object to what we see as an unwarranted attack on the public process conducted by Western. Evidence of this attack has been made clear by those who seek to have identification and disclosure of our confidential and proprietary data filed as part of Western's internal working papers. This is an effort to launch an assault on the allocations recommended by Western in its discretion under recognized federal law, rule and regulation which has been continually supported by the courts.

We do not wish the public to have access to our proprietary data to attack our application or the integrity of our participation in the open public process.
