## User information

### About this CD

This CD contains information on Western's power sales and revenues, the generation we market, our facilities and transmission lines, repayment, rates and project financial statements. This is the first year we've published our Statistical Appendix in a format other than print. When inserted into any standard PC, this CD will launch your Internet browser and will open a file called "**sa2001.htm**." This file is the main page of this self-guided tour.

### How to start the tour

**PC users:** (Microsoft Windows 95, 98, NT, ME, 2000, XP)

Insert this CD into your CD drive, and the program will automatically start the self-guided tour. If the program does not start by itself, you may begin the tour by double-clicking the file called "**autorun.exe**." If that does not work, open your Web browser. Browse/open the file called "**sa2001.htm**." From here, you may navigate to all of the documents on this CD. The text pages are in PDF files, and you must have the [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) to view them. Our sales and revenue data is also available in an Excel spreadsheet and requires Microsoft Excel to view.

#### Macintosh users:

Insert the CD and open the Web browser. Browse/open the file called "**sa2001.htm**." From here, you may navigate to all the documents on this CD. The text pages are in PDF files, and you must have the [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) to view them. Our sales and revenue data is also available in an Excel spreadsheet and requires Microsoft Excel to view.

### Other platforms

This CD and its files will not open automatically on Linux or Unix platforms. You must open your Web browser and browse/open the file called "**sa2001.htm**." From here, you may navigate to all the documents on this CD. The text pages are in PDF files, and you must have the [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) to view them. Our sales and revenue data is also available in an Excel spreadsheet and requires Microsoft Excel to view.

### Optimized viewing

Viewing these pages in Netscape Navigator 4 or higher or Internet Explorer 4 or higher will yield the best results. Adobe Acrobat Reader 3.0 or newer will read all files. Your browser should have options to view PDF files within your browser window rather than opening as a separate window. You must have Microsoft Excel to open our database spreadsheet (**sa2001.xls**).

### Browser note

Microsoft Internet Explorer expects a TCP/IP network connection (TCP/IP is used to access the Internet). If you are not configured with TCP/IP, Explorer will issue a warning. Ignore this warning—you will still be able to view all the documents on this CD, but not the Web sites linked to these documents.

Look for live Web links in the PDFs for greater functionality.

All PDF documents can be printed.

## **Accessibility**

All PDFs have been made accessible to the best of our ability using Adobe Acrobat's Make Accessible plugin. Some graphics within the PDFs may not read accurately.

- 2) Restart your computer without the CD in the CD drive.
