Dear Parker-Davis Project Customers and Interested Parties:

The Western Area Power Administration (Western) proposed extending the existing Parker-Davis Project (P-DP) formula rates in the *Federal Register* on June 11, 2013 (78 FR 35022). As a result of the public process, Western has recommended that the Deputy Secretary of Energy extend the existing formula rates through September 30, 2018.

Pending an extension of the formula rates, Western has calculated the rates for fiscal year 2014. Included in the rates are the results of the informal rate meeting held on June 20, 2013, and the Advancement of Funds (AOF) Funding Board Meeting held on July 18, 2013. Assuming the Deputy Secretary approves the extension, the firm electric and transmission service rates for fiscal year 2014 are as follows.

Energy and Capacity Components of Firm Electric Service (PD-F7)

Capacity Rate	\$1.86/kW-Month
Energy Rate	4.24 mills/kWh
Composite Rate	8.48 mills/kWh

Long-Term Firm Point-to-Point Transmission Service (PD-FT7)

Yearly Rate	\$15.36/kW-Year
Monthly Rate	\$ 1.28/kW-Month

Short-Term Firm Point-to-Point Transmission Service (PD-FT7)

Monthly Rate	\$1.28/kW-Month
Weekly Rate	\$0.2954/kW-Week
Daily Rate	\$0.0421/kW-Day
Hourly Rate	1.75 mills/kWh

Nonfirm Transmission Service (PD-NFT7)

Hourly Rate	1.75 mills/kWh
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Firm Transmission Service of Salt Lake City Area Integrated Projects Power (PD-FCT7)

Seasonal Rate	\$7.68/kW-season
Monthly Rate	\$1.28/kW-month
