Dear Central Arizona Project Customers and Interested Parties:

Attached for your use, is a copy of the Federal Register Notice (FRN) published in the *Federal Register* on July 24, 2015, entitled "Central Arizona Project-Rate Order No. WAPA-172." The FRN provides notice of Western Area Power Administration's (Western) proposed transmission rates for the Central Arizona Project.

Western will explain the proposed rates at a Public Information Forum, Thursday, August 27, 2015, 10 a.m. MST, at Western's Desert Southwest Regional Office, 615 South 43 Avenue, Phoenix, AZ, in Conference Rooms 3 and 4.

A Public Comment Forum for oral and written comments will be held on Thursday, September 24, 2015, 10 a.m. MST, at Western's Desert Southwest Regional Office, 615 South 43 Avenue, Phoenix, AZ, in Conference Rooms 1 and 2.

Western will accept written comments any time during the 90-day consultation and comment period. A preliminary rates brochure will be available shortly on Western's website at <https://www.wapa.gov/regions/DSW/Rates/Pages/central-arizona-rates.aspx>.

If you are a U.S. citizen, please be sure to bring an official form of picture identification (that meets the requirement of the Real ID Act), such as a driver's license, U.S. passport, U.S. Government ID, or U.S. Military ID, which you will be asked to show prior to signing in at Western.

If you are a foreign national and plan to attend, please contact Sylvia Macfarlane at 602-605-2664 or macfarl@wapa.gov, immediately to obtain the necessary form for admittance at Western. To allow time for background checks this form must be completed at least 30 days in advance for visitors from non-sensitive countries; and 45 days in advance for visitors from sensitive countries. Failure to complete this approval process may result in denial of visit.
