



Dear Mr. Keselburg,

Located in the Big Horn Basin, the town of Basin, Wyoming, is a small municipality with a peak demand of 2.5 MW. The town began operating as a municipal in 1902 and now serves approximately 700 customers located in or near the town. The town of Basin is interested in an allocation of federal power in accordance with the Federal Register, Vol. 72, No. 121, and would like preferential consideration as a potential WAPA customer. Since the town is a member of MEAN, Basin will likely be responsible for the scheduling and coordination of their transmission thru MEAN. The purchased power will serve the residents of the town of Basin including the Wyoming Retirement Center.

The town believes that based on the qualification criteria, it is eligible to be a WAPA preference customer. Any additional guidance in the process of obtaining an allocation of federal power will be appreciated. Please consider the town of Basin for the Loveland Area Projects resource pool. Thank you.
