As we do our part to limit the spread of coronavirus, WAPA employees have been directed to telework to the maximum extent possible for the next few weeks. We have not had any cases of or exposure to coronavirus at WAPA; our goal is to reduce the risk of exposure for as many employees as possible, especially those who work in mission-critical positions.
