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As you may be aware, [FERC did not approve SPP's WEIS tariff](#) on Friday. We understand SPP will work with stakeholders to address the items that FERC identified.

WAPA will continue to focus on meeting its goals for the WEIS implementation.

Although disappointed, we are not surprised. It is rare for a new market tariff to go through the first time. Any new market is going to encounter stakeholder protests and FERC modifications. There will likely be additional activity in these FERC proceedings. This is a standard process for FERC applications, and we look forward to working with SPP and our partners to move this effort toward implementation.

There were only five items out of the tariff that were highlighted by FERC as needing modification. In each case FERC provided clear guidance about what SPP will need to do to address them.

We will continue to frequently engage with you as this initiative moves forward. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to reach out.
