We wanted to provide a brief update on [Open Access Transmission Tariff Revision 20-02](#) for the Colorado River Storage Project's and Rocky Mountain's anticipated participation in the Southwest Power Pool-administered Western Energy Imbalance Service market.

On Dec. 23, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approved the WEIS Market Tariff filed by SPP and cleared the way for the WEIS Market to "go-live" Feb 1.

On Jan. 9, RM and CRSP Management Center posted the following **proposed** update to their "Assessing Unreserved Use Penalty" Business Practice related to the OATT Revision 20-02 updates for Stakeholder comment. The postings are located on the LAPT and CRCM OASIS home pages under the "Business Practices" folder, "Draft BP's - 10 Day Comment" sub-folder:

Comments regarding the proposed Business Practice updates must be submitted within 10 business days of the posting date to the RM and CRSP MC regional representatives, respectively. The planned effective date of the updated Business Practice is Feb. 1 to coincide with the expected "go-live" date of the WEIS Market. Notice of the Business Practice updates was also posted on the OASIS sites on the OATT Revision page above.

The next steps for OATT Revision 20-02 are:

- Effective date of OATT Revision 20-02 Feb. 1
- Notification by RM and CRSP MC of when they will begin active participation in the WEIS Market, which activates the provisions of OATT Attachment R, and is currently expected on planned Feb. 1 "go-live" date of the WEIS Market.
