A copy of the Federal Register notice initiating a public comment period about renewing the use of WAPA's Applicant Profile Data (APD) form, OMB Control No. 1910-1536, is enclosed and available at [www.gpo.gov/fdsys/pkg/FR-2017-05-18/pdf/2017-10046.pdf](http://www.gpo.gov/fdsys/pkg/FR-2017-05-18/pdf/2017-10046.pdf) as well as WAPA's Web page included below.

The Paperwork Reduction Act, 44 U.S.C. § 3501, et seq., requires WAPA to renew its authority to use the APD form once every three (3) years. WAPA's authority to use the APD form expires on September 30, 2017; and WAPA proposes to renew its authority through September 30, 2020.

As a courtesy to our interested stakeholders, we would like you to be aware of the process. If you have any comments about the APD form, please submit these as provided in the Federal Register notice. The comment period closes on July 17, 2017. The APD form is available on WAPA's Web page at [www.wapa.gov/PowerMarketing/Pages/applicant-profile-data.aspx](http://www.wapa.gov/PowerMarketing/Pages/applicant-profile-data.aspx).

Please note that the allocation of power is outside the scope of this proceeding; therefore, please do not submit a request for power under this public process.
