Gila-North Gila, North Gila-TS8 Transmission Projects



Learn more about the proposed rebuild and upgrade of two transmission lines between Gila and North Gila substations and land actions for portions of APS' North Gila-TS8 Transmission Project at an open house, February 7, 2013.

The proposed project includes:

- Upgrading Gila-Knob 161-kV to 230-kV using steel structures
- Rebuilding Gila-North Gila 69-kV transmission line as an underbuild on APS's new North Gila-TS8 structures.

APS is also proposing an alternative route around the Gila Substation.

Western will analyze the environmental impacts to resources in the proposed project area and assess APS' North-Gila TS8 Project as a connected action. Because the project crosses the Gila River and ephemeral washes, impacts to floodplains will also be analyzed. Your input is sought to help Western and APS identify impacts to be analyzed.


