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Dear Boulder Canyon Project Allottee:

In an effort to continue providing allottees with information regarding the draft electric service contracts, Western is extending an invitation to your organization to participate in a meeting to be held with other allottees in Arizona and Nevada. This meeting is scheduled to be held from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (MST) on Tuesday, May 5, 2015, at Western's offices located at 615 South 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona.

The purpose of this meeting is for Western to provide allottees with information regarding the draft electric service contracts, clarification of language, process to finalize contracts, and an opportunity to answer your questions. As mentioned in the email sent in March, the draft contracts are posted at the BCP Post-2017 Remarketing Website located at [http://www.wapa.gov/dsw/pwrmt/BCP\\_Remarketing/BCPPost2017.htm](http://www.wapa.gov/dsw/pwrmt/BCP_Remarketing/BCPPost2017.htm). Arizona Power Authority and Colorado River Commission allottees should contact their respective state agencies for further information on their contracts.

For those who are unable to attend the meeting, conference bridge information can be arranged upon request.

If you are a U.S. citizen, please be sure to bring an official form of picture identification (that meets the requirement of the Real ID Act), such as a driver's license, U.S. passport, U.S. Government ID, or U.S. Military ID, which you will be asked to show prior to signing in at Western.

If you are a foreign national and plan to attend, please contact Sylvia Macfarlane at 602-605-2664 or [Macfarl@wapa.gov](mailto:Macfarl@wapa.gov) immediately to obtain the necessary form for admittance at Western. To allow time for background checks this form must be completed at least 30 days in advance for visitors from non-sensitive countries; and 45 days in advance for visitors from sensitive countries. Failure to complete this approval process may result in denial of visit.
