5. Will a single loss rate be applicable to the projects? What is that loss rate?
6. Is WAPA considering MOD-30 (flow-based transmission modeling)? How would that impact a combined rate?
7. How will a combined rate be calculated and applied?
8. How will revenue be allocated among the projects?
9. Which current Parker-Davis Project customers would benefit?
