Dear Desert Southwest Region Customers and Interested Parties:

Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) will host Energy Imbalance Information Sessions on Tuesday, November 12, 2019 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. (MST) at its Phoenix office located at 615 South 43rd Avenue, Phoenix, AZ. WAPA's Desert Southwest Region will be facilitating information sessions over the coming months to provide details related to the operation of energy imbalance markets and to keep customers updated on progress related to the energy imbalance options study work currently underway. The morning session will feature representatives from the California Independent System Operator who will provide an overview of the Energy Imbalance Market. The afternoon session will feature representatives from the Southwest Power Pool who will provide an overview of the proposed Western Energy Imbalance Service.

Customers unable to attend the information session in-person may participate by joining the online conferencing via WebEx, which includes a dial-in conference bridge. The WebEx information will be posted on the Desert Southwest Energy Imbalance Market Activities webpage at <https://www.wapa.gov/regions/DSW/Pages/DSW-EIM.aspx> at least two weeks prior to the session.

Access to WAPA's facility requires U.S. citizens bring an official form of picture identification, such as a driver's license, U.S. passport, U.S. Government ID, or U.S. Military ID, which you will be asked to show prior to signing in.
