Sandee:

In terms of the calculation the New Melones entitlement, providing full requirements, and sharing of the entitlement with Tuolumne our comments remain the same as stated in CPPA's letter to Western dated May 22, 2015.

It is important for Western to uphold the provisions of the Flood Control Act of 1962 (76. Stat. 1180). In that regard, we request Western to clearly state in the 2025 PMP that any and all preference entities located within Calaveras County are eligible to join CPPA as members and receive power through CPPA irrespective if any of those entities receive a base resource allocation.

We recommend that Western develop a timeline for the 2025 PMP which would include: (1) major milestones during the process such as when the final PMP will be published, when new power service contracts will be forwarded to the customers, and how long the customers will have to review and execute the contracts; and (2) when Western plans to negotiate with PG&E the extension of the Wholesale Distribution Tariff Service Agreement.
