MID appreciates the opportunity to provide comments in the informal process related to the WAPA 2025 Power Marketing Plan.

MID supports the proposal that WAPA has been presenting with regards to the creation of resource pools based on taking 2% and 1% of all customer's base resource allocations in 2025 and 2040 respectively.

In addition, MID supports the concept of the reallocation of excess base resource product into the resource pool from customers whose base resource allocation exceeds load. In this way the excess base resource product is fairly distributed amongst customers that are already participants in the base resource pool that would have a need for that base resource allocation and any new applicants. MID believes that this reallocation of excess base resource product to existing customers would meet the marketing intentions of Federal Power of the Western Area Power Administration Sierra Nevada Region.
