Western Area Power Administration, an agency of the Department of Energy, will host a public scoping meeting on Wed., Dec. 16, 2009, at the Clear Lake Community Center. Heartland Wind, LLC, a subsidiary of Iberdrola Renewables, Inc., has submitted a request to Western to interconnect its planned Buffalo Ridge III Wind Project near the cities of White and Toronto, South Dakota, to Western's power transmission system at the White Substation. Western is preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS) to analyze the impacts of the interconnection.

The public meeting is from 6-8 p.m. A brief presentation about the project will begin at 6:30 pm. At the meeting, you can learn about the EIS process, meet project team members, ask questions, and provide comments. Your comments will help define issues and alternatives for evaluation in the EIS. Comments on the scope of the EIS are due to Western by Dec. 31, 2009.
