Dear Desert Southwest Region Customers and Interested Parties:

Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) has calculated the fiscal year (FY) 2023 charges for ancillary services provided by the Desert Southwest Region and Western Area Lower Colorado Balancing Authority (WALC). WAPA has also calculated the FY 2023 revenue requirements for Network Integration Transmission Service (Network) on the Pacific Northwest-Pacific Southwest Intertie Project (Intertie) and Parker-Davis Project (P-DP).

The charges for ancillary services and revenue requirements for Network are annual calculations under Rate Order No. WAPA-200. The following tables contain the specific charges and revenue requirements that will be effective on October 1, 2022.

INT-NTS4	Intertie Network	\$32,546,182 <sup>1</sup>
PDP-NTS4	P-DP Network	\$57,782,766 <sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The monthly charge is the product of the Network customer's load ratio share times one twelfth of the annual transmission revenue requirement for the applicable transmission system.
