2.	<p>WAPA-SN has extended the CVP rates for many years. Are you anticipating changes to the formulas?</p>	<p>WAPA-SN is not proposing any changes to the formula rates.</p>
3.	<p>a. The rates expire at different times. Are the new rates effective through fiscal year 2029?</p> <p>b. Will the new rates carry over to the new 2025 Power Marketing Plan?</p>	<p>The new rates will be effective through September 30, 2029.</p> <p>The new rates will continue to be effective under the 2025 Power Marketing Plan that begins on January 1, 2025.</p>
4.	<p>There have been negotiations with PG&E regarding the Wholesale Distribution Tariff (WDT).</p> <p>a. If not renewed, what does that look like for customers not directly connected to the SN grid?</p> <p>b. Does it only impact customers not connected to the SN grid, or does it also impact others?</p>	<p>WAPA-SN anticipates entering into another WDT agreement with PG&E. If not, customers would be responsible for arranging their own transmission and distribution service.</p> <p>WDT is for customers outside the SBA who need distribution service beyond the ISO grid, i.e, over PG&E's distribution system.</p>
