Dear Transmission and Ancillary Services Customers and Other Interested Parties:

This letter is to formally notify you of the Federal Register publications of the Rocky Mountain Region's (RMR) Loveland Area Projects, Western Area Colorado Missouri Balancing Authority, and Colorado River Storage Project Extension of Transmission and Ancillary Service Formula Rates - Rate Order No. WAPA-196 and the Loveland Area Projects and Western Area Colorado Missouri Balancing Authority's Transmission, Energy and Generator Imbalance, and Losses formula rates for use under the Western Energy Imbalance Service Market – Rate Order No. WAPA-197. Copies of the published Federal Register notices (FRNs) are enclosed for your convenience.

Signature and approval by the Interim Administrator, Tracey A. LeBeau, who was officially appointed WAPA Administrator, effective August 29, 2021, places the formula rates detailed in Rate Orders 196 and 197 into effect beginning October 1, 2021. The charges under the applicable formula rates are calculated annually and will be made available on WAPA's website.
