WAPA has issued a *Federal Register* notice initiating a public comment period about renewing the use of WAPA's Applicant Profile Data (APD) form, OMB Control No. 1910-5136.

The Paperwork Reduction Act, 44 U.S.C. § 3501, et seq., requires WAPA to renew its APD form once every three years. WAPA's APD form expires on March 31, 2024, and WAPA proposes to renew the APD form, with some ministerial changes, through March 31, 2027.

As a courtesy to our interested stakeholders, we want you to be aware of the process. If you have any comments about the APD form, please submit them as provided in the *Federal Register* notice. The comment period closes on Sept. 29, 2023. The proposed APD form, along with a list of ministerial changes (including a reason for the changes) is available on WAPA's website at: www.wapa.gov/PowerMarketing/Pages/applicant-profile-data.aspx.

Please note that this public process only examines renewing WAPA's APD form. It is a requirement under the Paperwork Reduction Act. The actual allocation of power is outside the scope of this proceeding; therefore, please do not submit a request for power under this public process.
