Dear Colorado River Storage Project Management Center Customer,

The Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) is expected to release the August Colorado River Simulation System (CRSS) traces within the first half of September 2023. That data, along with Reclamation's August 2023, 24-Month Study, will be added to the Power Repayment Study (PRS) to solve for rates under Rate Schedule SLIP F-13 in the WAPA-206 *Federal Register* notice (FRN). The August 2023 24-Month Study is used for purchased power and generation forecasts for Fiscal Years (FY) 2024 and 2025. The CRSS traces are used for purchased power and generation forecasts for FY 2026 through FY 2028.

**The proposed rates are:**

Energy: 12.36 mills/kWh  
Capacity: 5.25 \$/kW-month

**To allow customers the opportunity to review, and comment on the results of the August 2023 24-Month Study, as well as other aspects of the proposed rate, WAPA is offering a second virtual Comment Forum to be held, Tuesday, September 19, 2023, from 12:00 PM until comments are completed, or no later than 2:00 PM (MDT).** WAPA will send an email with the meeting details and a link to the virtual forum (Teams Application).

**In addition, the Customer Comment Period has been extended through Tuesday, October 3, 2023.** Written comments and requests for information pertaining to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) actions concerning these proposed rates, which WAPA will submit to FERC for approval, should be sent to:
