

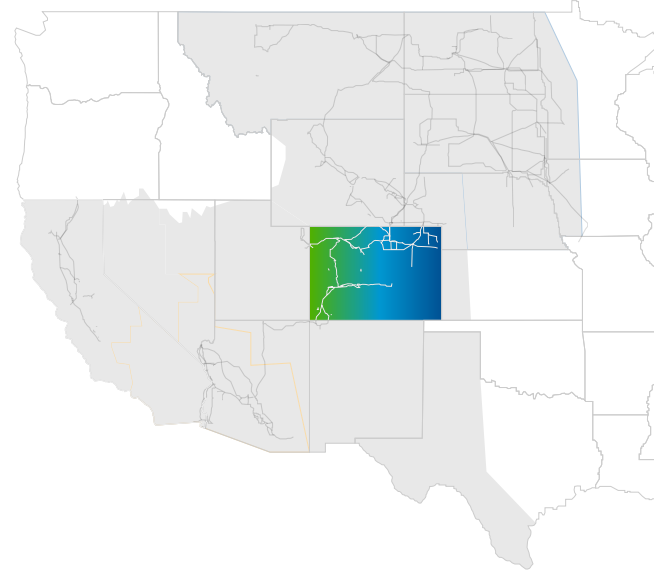
FACT SHEET

WAPA keeps the lights on for communities across the West and Great Plains. Our work ensures affordable energy reaches millions of people while supporting grid reliability and national security.



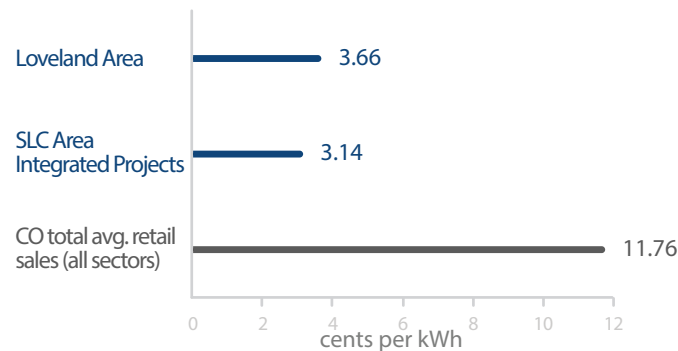
