Dear Transmission and Ancillary Services Customers and Other Interested Parties:

Western Area Power Administration's Colorado River Storage Project Region (WAPA-CRSP) has posted its final transmission and ancillary services formula rate template (Formula Rate Template), which sets forth revenues to be recovered under the Southwest Power Pool's (SPP) Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff) upon the Regional Transmission Organization (RTO) Expansion into the Western Interconnection, planned for April 1, 2026.

WAPA-CRSP's Formula Rate Template was initially posted October 27, 2025. Two adjustments have been made since the initial posting last October. Under approved Rate Order No. WAPA-220, WAPA-CRSP originally identified certain transmission assets as being in the Platte River Power Authority and Tri-State Generation and Transmission - West Zones. During the protocol process following the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) approval of WAPA-CRSP's Formula Rates, it was determined these assets are located in the CRSP Zone. Due to FERC's prior approval of the Formula Rate Template, WAPA-CRSP is unable to amend the Formula Rate Template; therefore, WAPA-CRSP has adjusted the relevant line items to zero and incorporated these assets into the CRSP Zone in the final posting of its initial April 2026 Formula Rate Template.

During the Protocol review period, Rocky Mountain Region (WAPA-RMR) revised their rate templates. Due to the nature of WAPA-RMR's cost allocation methodology, those revisions impacted WAPA-CRSP's Schedule 1 ATRR. Details pertaining to this change will be posted to WAPA-RMR's OASIS website located at www.oasis.oati.com/LAPT/index.html the week of January 26, 2026.

Overall, these changes resulted in a Schedule 9 (Network Transmission Service) revenue requirement increase of ~\$159k, or 0.2%. Schedule 1 (Scheduling, System Control and Dispatch) increased ~\$129k, or 2.9%. The WAPA-CRSP Formula Rate Template worksheets impacted by these changes include WS1, WS2, WS4, WS5, WS7, WS9, and WS12.
