To Central Valley Project Transmission Customers and Interested Parties:

Effective April 1, 2026, the Western Area Power Administration's (WAPA) Central Valley Project (CVP) point-to-point transmission rate will be \$1.86 per kilowatt-month (kW-month). The monthly Network Integration Transmission Service (NITS) revenue requirement will be \$2,470,815.

In accordance with Rate Order No. WAPA-207, Rate Schedules CV-T4 and CV-NWT6, WAPA may revise the rate when either of the following conditions occur: (a) updated financial data becoming available in March of each year, or (b) a change in the numerator or denominator resulting in a rate change of at least \$0.05 per kW-Month.

Based on updated financial and operational data, the rate change is an increase of \$0.15 per kW-month, which is primarily due to allocated costs associated with the California-Oregon Transmission Project Series Capacitors Replacement project.

The new rates and revenue requirement are listed in the table below.
